



Let's write poems about amphibians

You can write a poem in any style:

Rhyming:

Amphibians are toads.
Amphibians are frogs.
Amphibians are salamanders,
Hiding under logs.

Haiku (3 lines; 5-7-5 syllables per line)

Amphibian skin (5)
Should always be wet and cool. (7)
Better stay in shade. (5)

Free verse: (no rhyme needed; as many lines and syllables as you want.)

- 1) Frogs
Have such long legs
So they can jump and jump.

- 2) Salamanders
Kind of look like lizards,
But they're not.
Their skin is smooth.
And they would hate the sun.

Name poem:

TADPOLE

Tomorrow's frog
Always swimming
Down in the water
Pollywogs
Ot of eggs
Little
Eating algae

Cinquain (sin-kane)

(five lines; 2-4-6-8-2 syllables per line)

Water (2)
Is good for frogs, (4)
But sometimes toads (6)
Will hide under leaves; that is cool (8)
Enough (2)
