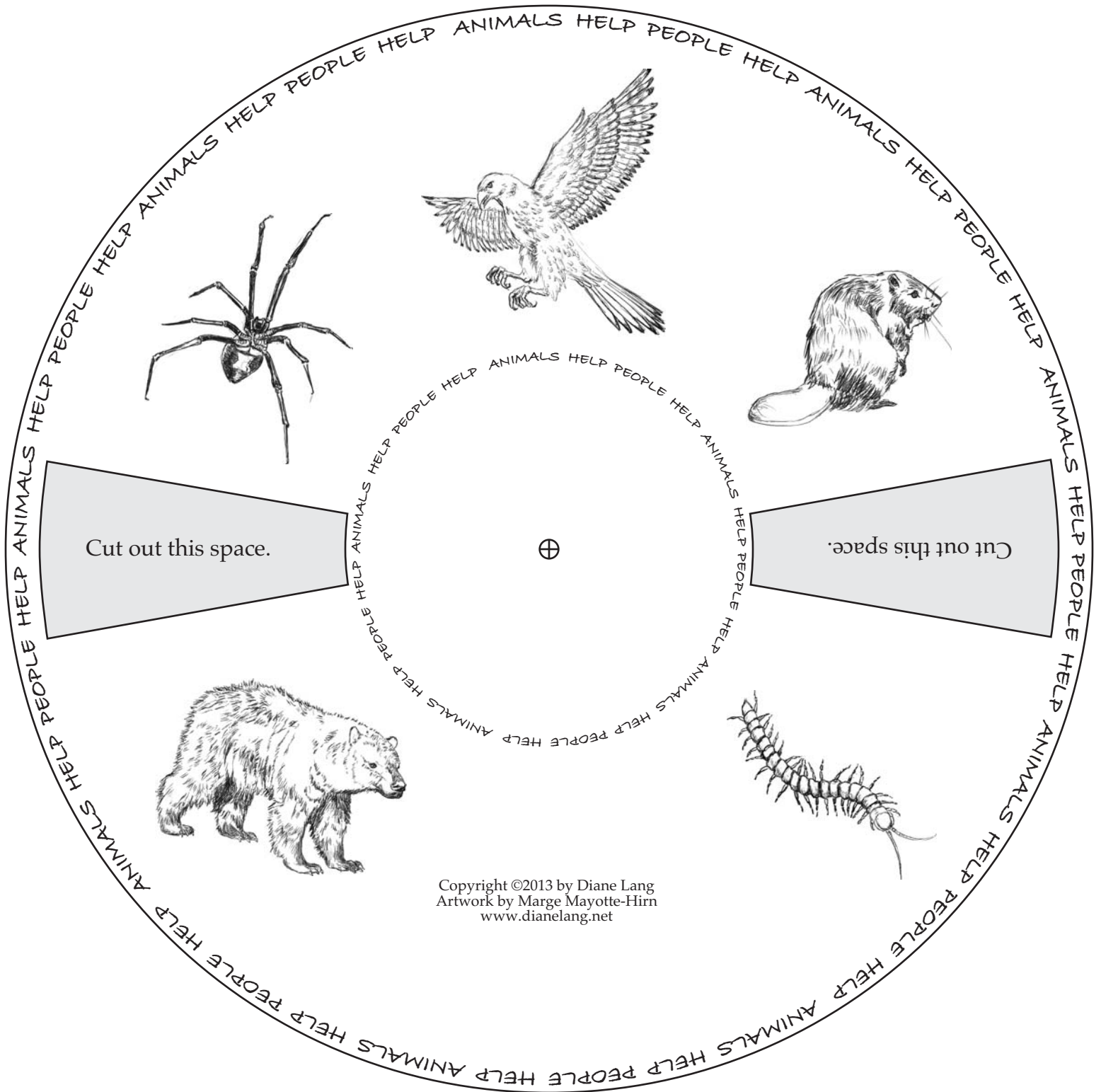
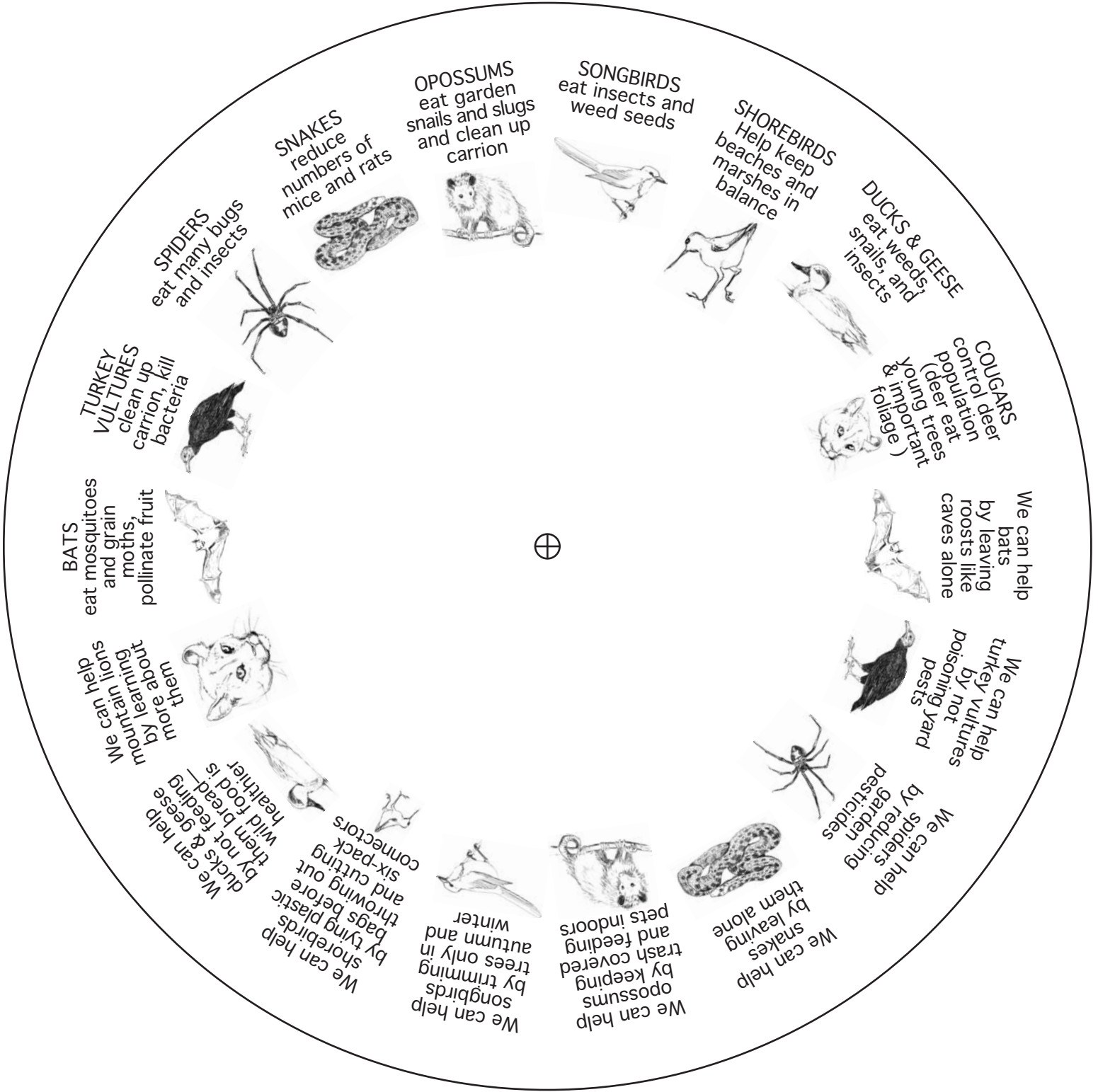


Cut out the circles on both pages, plus the windows on the first page. Join the two using a brad in the center, and find out how animals and people help each other.





**BATS**  
eat mosquitoes and grain moths, pollinate fruit

**TURKEY VULTURES**  
clean up carrion, kill bacteria

**SPIDERS**  
eat many bugs and insects

**SNAKES**  
reduce numbers of mice and rats

**OPOSSUMS**  
eat garden snails and slugs and clean up carrion

**SONGBIRDS**  
eat insects and weed seeds

**SHOREBIRDS**  
Help keep beaches and marshes in balance

**DUCKS & GEESE**  
eat weeds, snails, and insects

**COUGARS**  
control deer population (clear trees & important foliage)

We can help bats by leaving roosts like caves alone

We can help turkey vultures by not poisoning yard pests

We can help spiders by reducing garden pesticides

We can help snakes by leaving them alone

We can help opossums by keeping trash covered and feeding pets indoors

We can help songbirds by trimming trees only in winter

We can help shorebirds by tying plastic bags before throwing out six-pack connectors
