You can write a poem in any style:

Rhyming:

Blossoms in the springtime,
Crispy leaves in fall,
Squirrels running all year long.
I just love them all.

Haiku (3 lines; 5-7-5 syllables per line)

Sunlight at morning, (5)
Hearing the song of a bird. (7)
What is more lovely? (5)

Free verse: (no rhyme needed; as many lines and syllables as you want.)

I want to hike in the woods.
So many gifts!
- 2) The sun gives plants growing power,
Plants that give shade and food
To animals and to me.
What should I give the sun?

Cinquain (sin-kane) (five lines; 2-4-6-8-2 syllables per line)

Can I lie here until dinner? (8)
Or fall? (2)
